It's Time to Update Interior Design Regulation in New York State

A Modernized Scope of Practice - to elevate all facets of the profession.

Stamp and Seal Privileges - to create autonomy within the built environment.

Voluntary Registration - continuing opt-in registration to affect only those interested in stamp and seal.

New York's Professional Title Act (1990) is outdated and out of step with recent momentum around the country. While it established Interior Design as a distinct profession, it does not allow permitting privileges and perpetuates inequity within the built environment, as well as a restraint of trade.
